

Crowdy Head SLSC Equipment Form

Crowdy Head has a high standard for equipment and to maintain this we need everyone's co-operation. This form must be filled out every time you wish to borrow a piece of equipment from the Club and it must be signed at the bottom by the Director of Surf Sports or the Chief Gear Steward.

Rules for Borrowing Equipment:

1. You must gain permission from the Chief Gear Steward or Director of Surf Sports.
2. The equipment must be at the Club every Sunday it is not being used for competition or training.
3. The equipment must be transported in a cover and tied down with the correct straps.
4. If the ski is transported then it must have ski cradles fitted to the car. The Surf Club owns a universal set.
5. When equipment is in your care it must be stored in an undercover lockable location to stop theft and damage from the elements.
6. If the equipment is damaged you must not use it and contact the person that gave you permission to use it immediately.
7. If equipment is damaged you must pay half the cost of the repair to the Club.
8. If the piece of equipment is stolen while in your property you will have to pay for the cost of the piece of equipment.
9. If the piece of equipment is kept over the off season for training then it must be at the Club on the day of gear inspection. The Club will inform you about the date that this is on. If you fail to have the board at the Club on this date you will then be responsible to have the equipment inspected.

I _____ will follow the rules that are stated above and will take full responsibility for this equipment. By signing my name underneath I also understand the Clubs right to regain the piece of equipment if I break any of the Rules stated above.
